ROAD RALLY MONTH February

Each grade level will have the entire month of February (four weeks) to accumulate "miles". The class that travels the most "miles" around the race track by the end of February will be declared the winner. There will be a special award for the class that has journeyed the farthest.

Each grade level will be given specific Bible passages assigned for each week of the month, plus "bonus" memory work to recite. The bonus will usually be a review of a previous year's memory work.

"Miles" are earned in the following ways:

- 2 miles for each student present
- 3 miles for each student bringing a Bible to class
- 3 miles for each visitor brought by a member of the class to Sunday school
- 5 miles for each student learning the selected memory work for the week
- 10 miles for each visitor who brings a Bible and learns the memory work

- 10 miles for each student learning the bonus memory work

*A handicap based on average attendance has been calculated for each grade; therefore, each class has an equal opportunity to win.

_____ Week 1: **Eighth commandment and it's meaning**
You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor. What does this mean?
We should fear and love God so that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, slander him, or hurt his reputation, but defend him, speak well of him, and explain everything in the kindest way.

_____ Week 2: **James 4:11**
Brothers do not slander one another. Anyone who speaks against his brother or judges him speaks against the law and judges it.

_____ Week 3: **Luke 6:37**
Do not judge, and you will not be judged. Do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven.

_____ Week 4: **Proverbs 17: 17a**
A friend loves at all times.

_____ Bonus: **Luther's Evening Prayer**
I thank you, my heavenly Father, through Jesus Christ, Your dear Son, that You have graciously kept me this day; and I pray that You would forgive me all my sins where I have done wrong, and graciously keep me this night. For into Your hands I commend myself, my body and soul, and all things. Let Your holy angel be with me, that the evil foe may have no power over me. Amen.

April Memory Work

_____ **Tenth commandment and it's meaning.**

You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor. What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not entice or force away our neighbor's wife, workers, or animals, or turn them against him, but urge them to stay and do their duty.

_____ **Philippians 2:4**

Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others.
